SUPERINTENDENT’S REPORT

Mr. Alsept introduced Mr. Polen to the Board. He also talked about the Alternate Pathway to Graduation. He said that credentials will replace some of course exams. There is still discussion at the State level as to what the scores will need to be to pass the course. He also told the Board that the Buckeye Foundation had given 27 scholarships to our students. The scholarships were \$2500 for each. Currently there are 101 Seniors that will be receiving some scholarship or financial help with tools, etc. There were also 24 students inducted into the National Technical Honor Society. He said that these accomplishments, along with the students recognized earlier, show that our students are achieving locally, as well as nationally.
