BUILDING MAINTENANCE PROJECT

Farnsworth moved and Grandison seconded to accept the bid from Benchmark Construction, New Philadelphia, for the building maintenance project, including Alt G-1 for the aluminum windows, in the amount of \$789,734, base bid and \$6,196 for the Alt. G-1. Dave Zeller, MKC, said that it will take 6-7 weeks for the door frames to be ready for installation. The outside doors will be replaced one at a time so that the building will not be unsecure. Mr. Zeller said that there is other work that can be done while waiting on the doors. He said that the only challenge could be the electronic hardware. Mr. Callender, Supervisor and Mr. Zeller have met with Benchmark. Mr. Zeller also said that the project had been posted on the Builders Exchange and Dodge, in addition to the legal ad in the local newspaper.
